Monitored storm February 1-2, road closures, tree damages, power outages and any additional problems- freezing rain/ice. Also monitored a possible ice storm on February 18-20 which began in southern states a few days earlier.

Updated emergency evacuation agreement between Sunshine Cove Day Care (formerly Wee Care Day Care) and Spruce Head Community Church.

Attended remotely 2- Knox County EMA Directors meeting.

Attended remotely, CDC briefing on vaccine availability and distribution of vaccines in future. 65 yr old group to begin vaccinations after 2/3 of 75+ age group is completed. Expecting to start those vaccinations the first/second week of March.

Monthly AED inspections at both Library and Spruce Head Community Church Shelters and performed monthly maintenance on emergency generator at the Library/ Keag Shelter.

Attended Budget review meeting with Selectboard.
