#### I. Call to Order

Reitz called the meeting to order at 6:02

#### II. Adjustments to Agenda

There was one adjustment to the agenda. At the conclusion of this meeting the board will continue as a selectboard or consider executive session to discuss a Personnel matter. 1 M.R.S.A. § 405 (6)(a)

#### III. Public Comment for Items not on the Agenda

There was no public comment.

#### IV. Approve Minutes

The Budget committee approved their minutes of March 30, 2021 and Nov 5, 2020.

Gaudio moved and Spear seconded a motion to approve the minutes of March 30, 2021 as amended.

#### Motion passed 3-0

#### V. 2021-2022 Budget Review

a. Town Road
Department 610

Baines presented Grierson's Budget. There was a discussion on paving.

The Budget Committee tabled the Town Roads.

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to table the Town Roads budget until the following night.

#### Motion passed 3-0

The Budget Committee tabled the Paving Reserve.

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to table the Paving Reserve until the following night.

#### Motion passed 3-0

#### b. Solid Waste Department 630

Baines presented Grierson's Solid Waste Budget.

The Budget Committee preliminarily approved 630 Solid Waste in the amount of \$462,862.

There was a discussion on the transfer station and demo debris facility (stump dump).

Gaudio moved and Spear seconded a motion to approve 630 Solid Waste in the amount of \$462,862.

#### Motion passed 2-1

#### c. Town Landing

Baines presented the budget.

The Budget Committee preliminarily approved the budget in the amount of \$6278.

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to preliminarily approve the Town Landing budget in the amount of \$6278

#### Motion passed 3-0

#### d. Administration

Baines presented the budget.

The Budget Committee voted to preliminarily approve the Administration budget in the amount of \$391,186.

Spear discussed the Town Administrator salary increase. Spear opposes the performance awards line and made a motion to reduce the proposed Administration budget by \$3,750.

Motioned died

There was a brief discussion on performance awards, salaries and hiring.

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to preliminarily approve the Administration budget in the amount of \$391,186.

Motion passes 3-0.

## e. Social Services 640

Baines presented the budget. Paddock explained general assistance for the new members.

The Budget Committee preliminarily approved the Social Services budget in the amount of \$2250.

Gaudio moved and Spear seconded a motion to preliminary fund 640 Social Services in the amount of 2250.

This ended the agenda items for March 31st.

There was a discussion on building and grounds improvements and LD1.

The Selectboard and Budget Committee opted to take up Debt Service and Recreation budgets.

#### f. Debt Service 670

Baines presented the budget.

The Budget Committee preliminarily approved the Debt Service budget in the amount of \$80,379.

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to preliminarily approve the Debt Service budget in the amount of \$80,379.

## g. Recreation 680

Baines presented the Recreation budget.

There was a discussion of Oceanside Little League. Money is budgeted in dues Fees and travel to support South Thomaston players in the league. Spear gave an update on the tennis/basketball courts project.

The Budget Committee preliminarily approved the Recreation budget in the amount of \$5505.

Gaudio moved and Spear seconded a motion to preliminary fund Recreation in the amount of \$5505.

#### Motion passed 3-0

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to enter executive session pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. § 405 (6)(a) to discuss a Personnel matter.

#### Motion passed 3-0

The Selectboard entered executive session at 8:40.

The Selectboard exited executive session at 9:12

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to adjust the Fire Chief's pay for the 6 month period of the 18-month budget to \$3933 and we adjust the Fire Chief's pay for the 12-month period to \$9,366. This will be his annual base.

#### Motion passed 3-0

Gaudio moved and Spear seconded a motion to raise the Deputy Chief's pay for the 6 month period to \$1,560 and the 12-month period to \$3,220.

Motion passed 3-0.

#### VI. Adjournment

Spear moved and Gaudio seconded a motion to adjourn at 9:15 pm.
