

GENERAL ASSISTANCE NOTICE

The municipality of South Thomaston administers a General Assistance program for the support of the poor. Pursuant to Title 22 MRSA & 4305, the municipal officers have adopted an ordinance establishing that program. A copy of this ordinance is available for public inspection at the town office. Also available for inspection is a copy of the State's General Assistance Statutes, as copies of the State law are made available to the municipality by the Maine Department of Human Services.

Persons who wish to apply for General Assistance may do so by appointment at the Town Office, 125 Spruce Head Road, South Thomaston during the following times:

In an emergency, when the office is closed, applicants may contact Knox County Dispatch at 594-9386

The Municipality's General Assistance Administrator must issue a written decision within 24 hours of receiving an application.
